Welcome to the Season of Giving!

We are excited to announce that Mont Vernon has just released the final Request for Proposals (RFP) for the New Library Project. The MVLCF board has been working closely with the Library Trustees (Trustees) to achieve this significant milestone. The Trustees seated a Library Building Committee (LBC) in September that has been meeting frequently to finalize the Library design with the architect DSK. The LBC is a collaborative committee that includes members of the community, advisory members from the Daland Trustees, the Library Director, a Selectmen's Representative and the Chair of the Library Trustees. Members of the LBC traveled to DSK and the DSK team came to Mont Vernon to review all the details. Everyone has been excited to see the new renderings that show the chosen wood tones, flooring, tile, fabric, and paint colors. These preliminary decisions were required to ensure accurate bids. The Trustees received the final design from DSK and the RFP was sent to eight NH-based construction management (CM) firms for competitive



bids due in January. The LBC will review the bids and recommend a CM selection to the Trustees. The Trustees expect to develop a Warrant Article for March 2023.

The next three months of fundraising are critical to reduce the tax impact of the project when it is presented at Town Meeting next March.
