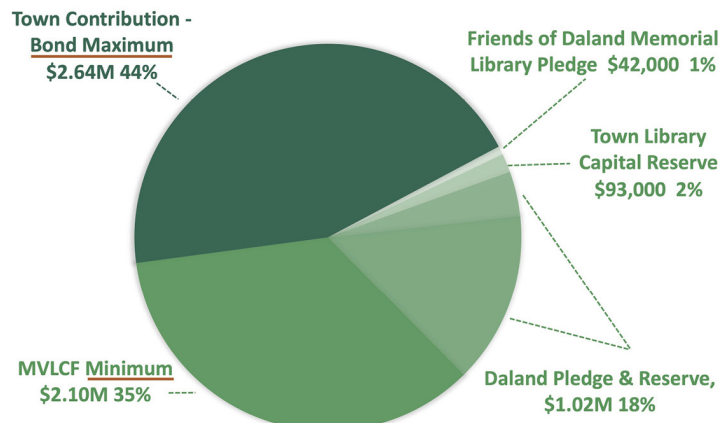
Hi Everyone!

On behalf of the Library Trustees, we are thrilled to share with our donors that a Warrant Article for the new library has been submitted! The Library Trustees, together with the Library Building Committee (LBC) received multiple project bids from construction firms and have chosen Turnstone Corporation of Milford, NH. Members of the LBC spent months meeting to find cost saving changes to the design to reduce the overall cost without changing the vision. The result is a beautiful building design at a cost the Library Trustees hope the town can support. Thanks to the success of the foundation and generosity of our donors, the Library Trustees expect the Select Board to ask the taxpayers for \$2.64 million dollars in a 30 year bond representing just 44% of the total cost of the project.

Members of the Library Building Committee, the MVLCF Board, DSK Architects+ Planners, and Turnstone Corp. will also be attending. Residents of Mont Vernon are encouraged to attend with questions, comments, or concerns before Town Meeting.

SAVE THE DATE! Town Voting Tuesday, March 14th 7am-7pm & Town Meeting Wednesday, March 15th 7pm. The most important thing you can do as a resident of Mont Vernon to get a new library, is to make a plan to **VOTE AT TOWN MEETING!** The library warrant will require a 3/5th vote on the floor of Town Meeting. Make a plan to arrive early and check in with ID on Wednesday, **MARCH 15TH** to the Mont Vernon Village School MPR. Voting will begin in the first hour of the meeting and each vote will be open for one hour. Because it is a bond, the vote will be done by secret ballot with a slip of paper and wooden ballot box the good old-fashioned way! It is critical for every registered voter who supports a new library to be at Town Meeting to vote YES for both the library itself and the cemetery access road! The Time is Now!

As a donor, you can help campaign for the YES! vote by adding a library campaign sign to your front lawn, joining the team who is getting out the vote by dropping off door hangers, or hosting a party to encourage friends and neighbors to vote for the project.
